



AIM Harvest Summary: Weeks of 5/30 and 6/6

3 person crew (2 divers)

Week 1

The Saginaw Bay transect area was covered into Pork Bay (22 plants along that shore).

Pork Bay got a full-coverage swim, 4 bags harvested in the deeper sections of the bay showing up out by the drop off. The shallows of Pork Bay had very little growth (7 plants).

The Point at the South end of Pork Bay heading South through narrows (42 plants total)

Gilpin Bay received a full coverage swim with 70 plants harvested.

North Gull Bay received a full coverage swim with 50 plants harvested throughout the bay.

South Gull Bay had 150 plants scattered throughout the bay

5 bags total for the week, 125 lbs.

Week 2

Doctor's Island rocks and shoreline from S. end of South Gull heading south behind Doctor's Island held 1 full bag of plants. They were small and numerous making this area a priority for future management.

Bartlett Carry Bay produced 25 plants total, primarily in the eastern end of the bay near the canoe carry.

Birch Island produced 60 plants throughout the wide littoral area including the marked boating channel.

Deer Island held 75 plants mostly along the west side of the island.

The Wawbeek area swimming north to point west of Bungalow Bay produced 4 plants only.

The small bay near camp Wenona held 1 full bag also making this area a priority for future management.

Bungalow and Pelky Bays held 225 plants, small and scattered mixed in with bassweed.

North side of Eagle Island held 6 plants.

3 bags harvested with a total weight of 75 lbs.
