



**AIM Harvest Summary: Weeks of 6/13 and 6/20/11**

**3 person crew (2 divers)**

### **Week 5**

June 13<sup>th</sup>,  
Started swimming from the sand bar at the entrance to Back Bay and continued up the shore into North Bay. On this entire swim we found 1 plant on the west shore of Back Bay. We moved to an area on the north facing side of Markham Point finding a small patch of 15 plants.

June 14<sup>th</sup>,  
Little Square Bay. We picked 3 1/2 bags of milfoil mainly in the tongue area. Plants were mostly new growth.

June 15<sup>th</sup>,  
Finished swimming Little Square Bay tongue area and transect area. This produced another 1/2 of a bag making it a total of 4 1/2 bags. This bay will need to be re swam throughout the summer. We moved to Square Bay where we found two patches on the north eastern shore producing 2 1/2 bags. Plants were mostly new growth however, some multi-stemmed plants were harvested. These areas will need to be re swam.

June 16<sup>th</sup>,  
Continued swimming the rest of Square Bay and into the divot, harvesting 1 more bag of milfoil. Plants were mostly in the back area of square bay and the divot. This area will need to be re swam as well.

**Totals – 7 bags            175 lbs**

### **Week 6**

June 20<sup>th</sup>,  
Square Bay Divot to Saginaw bay we picked 1 1/2 bags most plants were on the east shore behind buck island and out in the channel behind buck. We also found a small patch on the northern shore of Saginaw.

June 21st,

Finished swimming Saginaw found 150 plants in shallow area on the south shore of the bay. Moved into pork bay where we picked 2 bags in the deeper part of the bay.

June 22<sup>nd</sup>,

Finished Swimming Pork Bay where we picked 1 more bag. Most plants were new growth but some tall older plants were found. This area will need to be re-swam periodically throughout the summer. Once pork was finished we headed south into the narrows where 75 plants were picked mainly in divot just south of pork bay.

Moved to the rock pile on the north shore of Buck Island and swam the west shore of the island where we found 60 plants.

June 23<sup>rd</sup>,

Finished swimming the west shore of Buck Island and the south shore where 50 more plants were found. Moved to bottle bay where 1/2 of a bag was picked. Most plants were in the divot to the north of bottle bay.

**Totals - 5.5 bags      137.5 lbs**
