



AIM Harvest Summary: Week of 8/29

Operations:

Monday- Began at Burnt Point swimming south and finishing just North of the Island in Clark Hollow Bay. Significant growth was harvested on the South side of Burnt point (narrow band of mature plants). A large band of growth was harvested from the North side of the point North of Clark Hollow Bay continuing into the bay and stopping just North of the Island. 9 bags were harvested.

Tuesday- Began just North of the Island in Clark Hollow Bay swimming South and ended at the Point just South of Racket Island. This swim had very small amounts of growth with significant pockets around the Island in Clark Hollow Bay and the skinny point on the South end of Clark Hollow Bay. 3 bags were harvested.

Wednesday- Began at the Point just South of Racket Island swimming South and ended on the Northern side of Bluff Head. Significant growth was harvested from the shallow bay East of the Odell Islands and around the small island within that bay. 7 bags were harvested.

Thursday- Began on the Northern shore of Bluff Head swimming South and ended on the Southern side of the Point North of Agnes Island. Significant growth was harvested from the second point south of Bluff Head. 8 bags were harvested.

All areas covered were also inspected for Asian Clams with none found throughout the week.

Weekly Bag count: 27 bags 675 lbs

Recommendations: All involved shore-owners expressed their gratitude and mentioned donating to the Fund as a result of seeing the work being done. In the future this shoreline will be covered more quickly now that dense established bands and patches have been suppressed.
